## \*Important Notice:

The Wildwood Lake Trail can be accessed at the main entrance to Wildwood Conservation Area at 3995 Line 9, St. Marys. (Highway 7 between Stratford and Highway 119)

All cyclists must enter the trail via the trail head located at the gatehouse. Access is strictly enforced.

All trail users must possess a Seasonal Pass or Daily Pass receipt. Passes are available at the gatehouse. Trail pass revenue contributes to trail improvement and management.

The Lake Trail is closed from dusk to dawn. Night riding is prohibited.

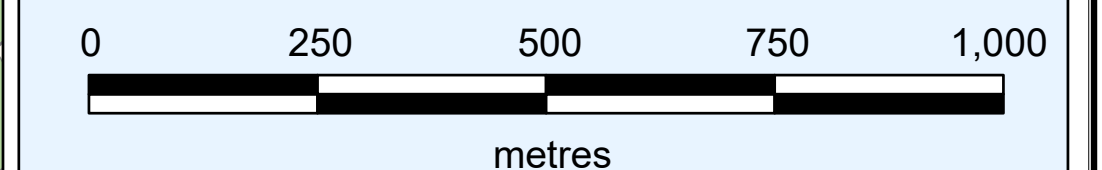
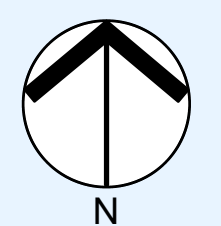
Caution! Sections of the Lake Trail are "on road".

On **EVEN** numbered dates (e.g. June 2, 14, etc.)  
 All bikers travel **clockwise** around the lake.

On **ODD** numbered dates (e.g. June 1, 13, etc.)  
 All bikers travel **counter-clockwise** around the lake.
